Take an image (photograph) of the completed Covering Certificate and text and/or email the image to both yourself and the mare owner. Give the completed Covering Certificate to the mare owner. It is advisable that you download from your mobile phone or email the image of Covering Certificate and print it so that you can keep it filed in case you cannot locate the original image taken on your mobile phone.		Take an image (photograph) of the Covering Certificate as provided by the stallion owner. When applying online for issue of a studbook passport for the foal you will be required to upload an image of the Covering Certificate. However, if you sell the mare before the foal is born you must give the Covering Certificate (as provided by the stallion owner) to the new owner so that they can apply online for issue of a studbook passport for the foal.
